



- "The circumstances in which people are born, grow up, live, work and age, and the systems put in place to deal with illness. These circumstances are in turn shaped by a wider set of forces: economics, social polices, and politics." WHO
- Scientific evidence suggests that social and economic conditions drive population health to an equal or greater degree as do individual choice, genetic make-up and access to health care.
