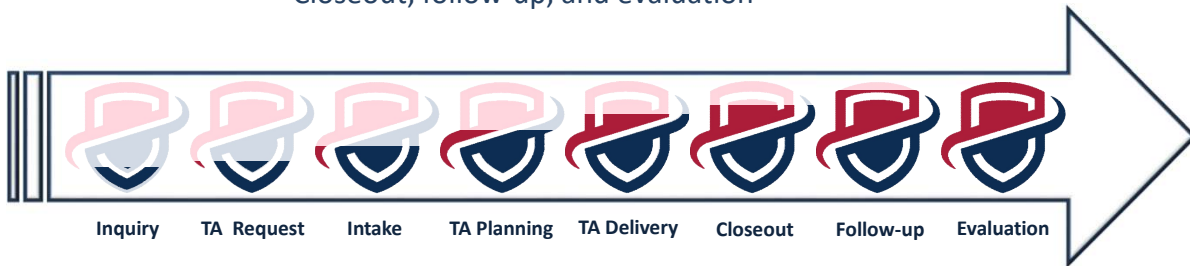


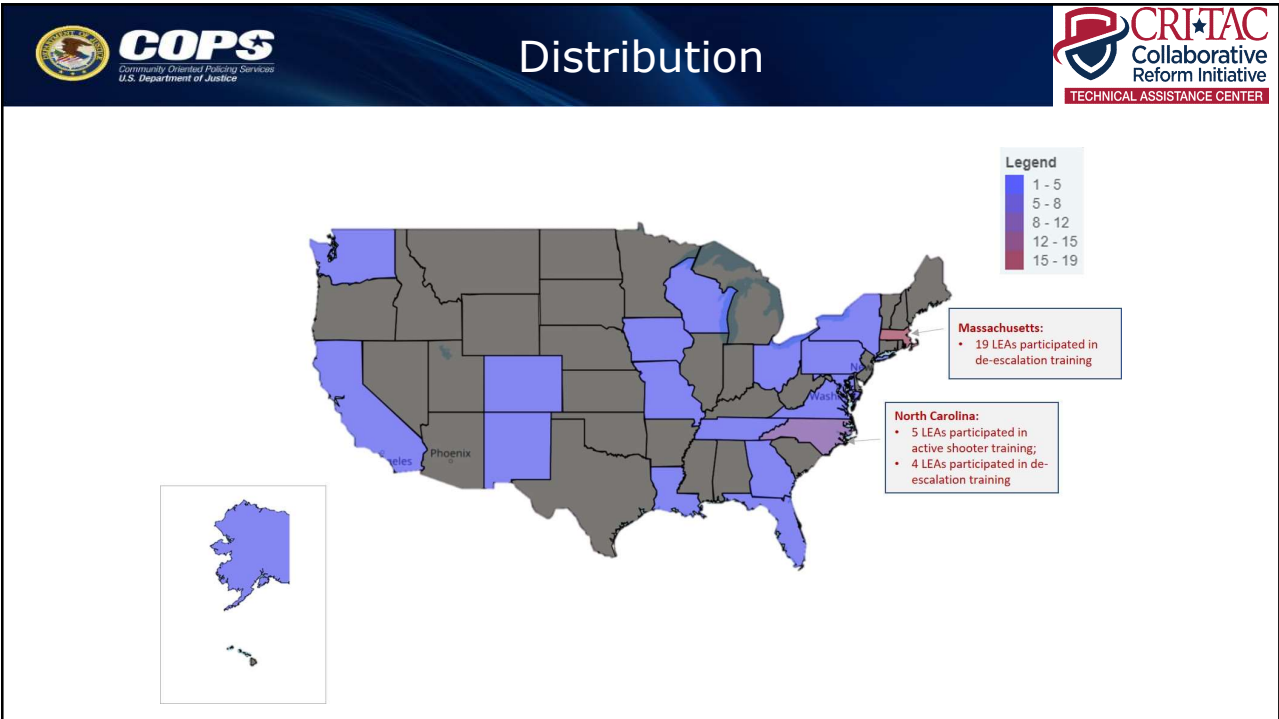
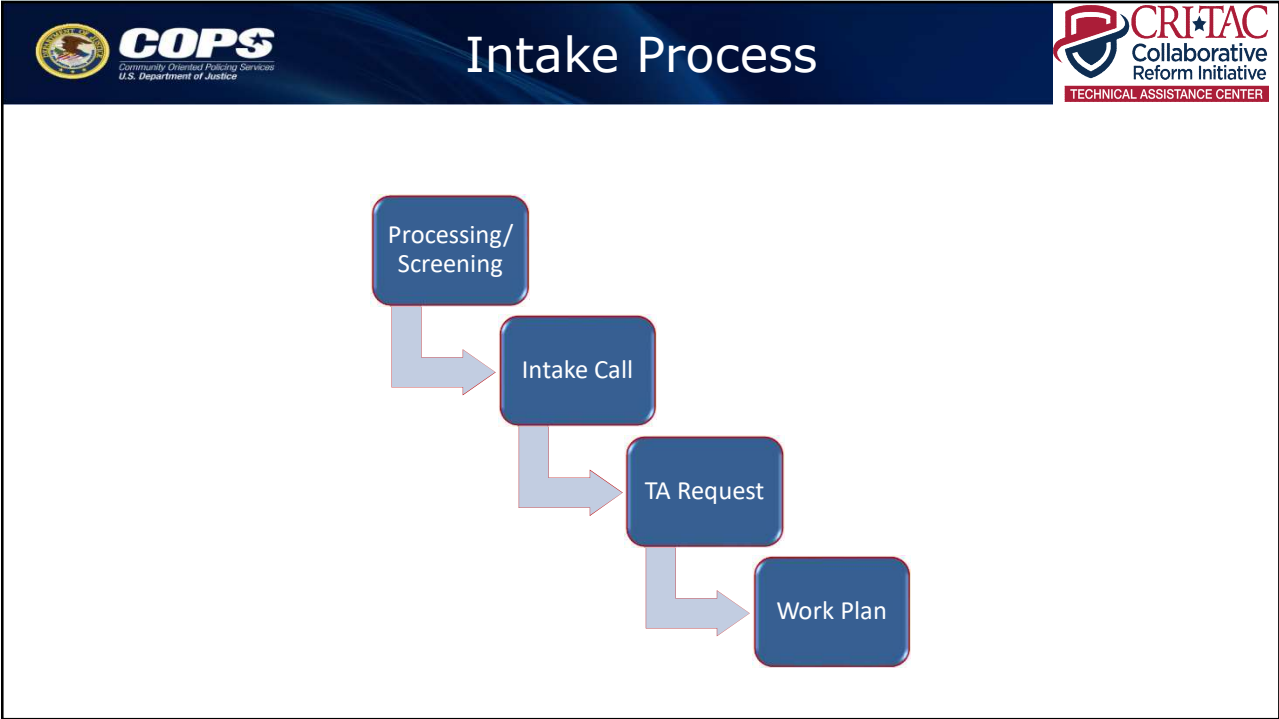
# CRI-TAC Process

- 🛡️ School and workplace violence seminar

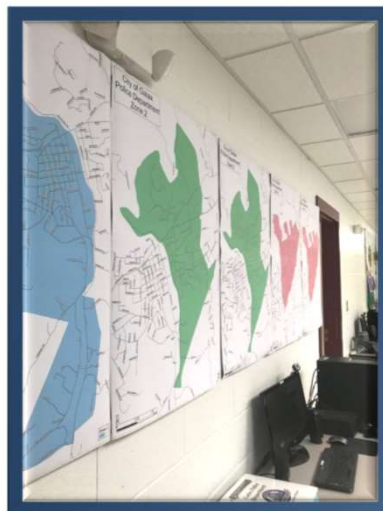


## CRI-TAC Case Study #2
